WHO: Beaufort County Democratic Party, Indivisible, Women's March

WHAT: Peaceful demonstration in response to actions by the Trump administration.

(Beaufort County, SC) - On Saturday, April 5, the Beaufort County Democratic Party joins the Women's March, Indivisible, and 50501 Movement for a National Day of Action. Protests are planned in Beaufort and Bluffton, with local speakers addressing issues affecting many of Beaufort County's families: losing access to social security and Medicaid, voting rights, civil rights, immigration rights, and veteran's concerns.

"From rising prices and unstable markets to the rapid loss of human rights, social services, and jobs, Beaufort County residents from all walks of life are reeling from the effects of damaging Republican policies. This national day of action shows our elected representatives and neighbors that the people of Beaufort County reject the harmful Republican agenda that is being implemented in both Columbia and DC.", said Chairperson Kathleen Hughes.
